



## Online Professional Development

Educators can access Keys to Literacy professional development through our online training courses. Each course is organized into modules that include interactive activities, readings, video clips from live training, and activities that allow users to master course content. Online courses are asynchronous which means users can complete the course at their convenience; they may log in at any time to work through the modules at their own pace.

The courses can be taken by individual teachers who register directly with KTL, or through a school/district that has contracted with KTL to provide a course to educators. Course guides are available for those who facilitate or supervise group participation in a course.

<p><i>The Key Comprehension Routine: Grades 4-12</i> A copy of the <i>Keys Comprehension Routine</i> training book is included.</p> <p>This course is appropriate for all grades 4-12 educators. <p><i>The Key Comprehension Routine: Primary Grades K-3</i> A copy of the <i>Key Comprehension Routine Primary</i> training book is included.</p> <p>This course is appropriate for all grades K-3 educators. Topics covered include: oral language as a foundation for comprehension, text structure (sentence, paragraph, narrative and expository), categorizing and main idea skills, topic web graphic organizer, two column notes, retell and summary, question generation.</p>	9.5	
<p><i>The Key Vocabulary Routine: Grades 2-12</i> A copy of the <i>Key Vocabulary Routine</i> training book is included.</p> <p>This course is appropriate for all grades 2-12 educators. <p><i>Keys to Content Writing: Grades 4-12</i> A copy of the <i>Keys to Content Writing</i> training book is included.</p> <p>This course is appropriate for all grades 4-12 educators. Topics covered include: the writing process, quick writes, basic text structures (argument, informational, narrative), writing from sources, writing models and mentor text, explicit instruction and scaffolds, feedback and revision, writing assignment planning guide.</p>	14	
<p><i>Keys to Early Writing: Grades K-3</i> A copy of the <i>Keys to Early Writing</i> training book is included.</p> <p>This course is appropriate for all grades K-3 educators. Topics covered include: early developmental stages, the language-literacy connection, using read aloud to teach print and writing concepts, suggestions for engaging a community of writers (collaboration, opportunities for feedback, student choice), daily writing using quick writes, sentence/paragraph writing, transitions, opinion/information/narrative text structure, stages in the writing process, writing from sources, writing scaffolds, writing activity guide.</p>	16

You will learn numerous instructional practices for teaching students how to generate questions to support comprehension. The course provides professional development for teaching note taking in any subject. You will learn numerous instructional practices for a variety of literacy skills that students must learn in order to take quality notes. You will also learn scaffolds that can be used to differentiate your instruction to meet individual student needs.</p>	5	\$59
<p><i>Keys to Literacy Comprehension Coach Training</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Training to become a school peer coach for <i>The Key Comprehension Routine</i></li> </ul> <p>This course is appropriate for any educator who is preparing to be a peer coach in their school or district for <i>The Key Comprehension Routine</i>. The course provides background knowledge about peer coaching and an advanced review of the two grade-level versions of the program: <i>The Key Comprehension Routine Grades 4-12</i> and <i>The Key Comprehension Routine Grades K-3</i>. This is an asynchronous and facilitated course. Upon completion, you will be prepared to provide coaching.
